# **NOTICE OF RACE R00**

# 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

# 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the I-14, 49er & 49er FX classes.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form (https://www.i14.ca/2020-canadian-championships) and paying the appropriate fee via e-transfer.

# 3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

# 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1130hrs.
- 4.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1600hrs.

# 5 MEASUREMENT

5.1 Each boat shall conform to their fleets class rules.

#### **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after September 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### 7 VENUE

- 7.1 The Venue will be Water Rats Sailing Club. Competitors may arrive after Thursday September 17<sup>th</sup> at noon. Arrangements will be made to meet competitors for entry to WRSC.
- 7.2 The racing area will be on Lake Ontario south of the Toronto Islands.

#### 8 COURSES

8.1 The Courses to be sailed shall be windward leewards for the 49er/FX classes and Triangle Windward Leeward for the I-14 class.

# 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.2 For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### 10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2 1 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4 OCS/UFD/BFD for the 49er/FX shall not to be discarded.

# 11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

# 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

# 13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

# **International 14**

The boat in first place after the first day of racing will be awarded the Itchenor Trays.

The winner of the Canadian Championships will be awarded the C.W. Bourke Trophy .

The winning crew will be awarded the Davis Trophy.

If a long-distance race is held the Viscount Trophy shall be awarded to the first boat.

### 49er & FX

A cash prize shall be awarded to the top 3 49er/FX teams, details to be posted.

#### 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

# 15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2 000 000 per incident or the equivalent.

# 17 COVID-19 SAFTEY GUIDLINES

All competitors will be required to keep face masks/buffs on their person while racing. While ashore competitors should remain 2m apart when possible. Competitors must also fill out the COVID-19 Waiver prior to competing.
